

CALL FOR FINE CRAFT

The Craft Council of NWT (CCNWT) in conjunction with the Alberta Craft Council (ACC) and the support of the NWT Arts Program, are seeking submissions of traditional and contemporary fine craft for exhibit and sale in the ACC Gallery in Edmonton, Alberta. This exhibit and sale will be open January to April 2021.

To be considered, you must:

- Currently reside in the NWT.
- Be registered with the NWT Arts Program (www.nwtarts.com).
- Be a member of the Craft Council of NWT (fees will be waived if chosen).

To apply, send the following information before Friday, October 30, 2020 to nwtarts@gov.nt.ca:

- Your full name and community of residence.
- Your current phone number and email address.
- Three photos representative of your current artwork.
- A statement detailing why you are interested in this opportunity.
- What you would create for the exhibit, its materials and general size(s). We are looking for 2-4 pieces per Artisan.
- If the pieces would be for sale and what the retail price would be.

Terms:

- The CCNWT together with the ACC and NWT Arts Program will gently jury submissions for quality, workmanship and variety.
- Approximately 15 Artisans will be chosen for this opportunity.
- Chosen Artisans must be able to provide 2-4 pieces of work for the exhibit.
- Chosen Artisans will receive CARFAC fees of \$400 each.
- The retail price of any work will be split 60% to the Artisan, 40% to the ACC.
- Shipping and insurance will be paid by the NWT Arts Program, both ways.
- Work must be received in Yellowknife by December 11, 2020.
- The NWT Arts Program will work with chosen Artisans to ensure they are market ready for this event (updated profiles etc.)
