

Call for Visual Artists

The Snowking's Winter Festival, in partnership with the NWT Arts Program, is hosting a NWT Furday on Saturday, March 4 from 1:30-4:00pm in the Great Hall of the Snowcastle in Yellowknife. There will be a Flaunt your Fur photobooth, beaver skinning demonstration, games for kids, and more!

NWT Arts is inviting artists who mainly work with fur to participate in two of the activities that day: Fur Market and the Fur Fashion Show. To participate in these opportunities, you must be registered in the NWT Arts Program and currently reside in the NWT. There is no cost to participate, and no honorariums will be provided.

Fur Market

- There are six spots available for the market.
- Spots will be booked on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Artists must be able to stay outside for the duration of the market.
- Artists may bring someone to assist them with their table.
- Tables and linens will be provided.
- Setup will take place from 1pm-1:30pm.
- The market will be open from 1:30-4:00pm.

Fur Fashion Show

- There are 6 artist spots available, with up to 3 “looks” each.
- A “look” could contain multiple pieces (ie. Clothing, necklace, earrings, bracelet).
