Manitobah (formerly Manitobah Mukluks), in partnership with the NWT Arts Program is putting out a call to showcase and sell the work of NWT Indigenous visual artists starting in May 2024 through the Manitobah online Indigenous Market.



Manitobah is committed to providing a platform for authentic Indigenous art that encourages pride, shapes lives and helps keep traditions alive.

To be considered for this opportunity, you must meet all of the following criteria and agree to these terms:

- Are registered in the NWT Arts Program and currently reside in the NWT.
- Are ready to exhibit and sell your work outside of the territory.
- Can supply additional pieces of work when items sell.
- Are willing to work with Manitobah on retail pricing of your pieces.
- Agree to a 7.5% administration fee per item(s) sold. This fee covers the facilitation of sales, shipping and handling.
- Shipping/insurance to Manitobah and back (if applicable) will be covered by the NWT Arts Program.
- Submit a completed **online application form** by Friday, May 31, 2024.
