NACC Seeking Artists for Artist of the Month Exhibit for the 2021 Season
Featured artists will have their art displayed at NACC during performances, on-line and available for sale.

Yellowknife, NT: Northern Arts and Cultural Centre (NACC) is seeking Northwest Territories (NWT) artists to present a collection of their work as part of NACC's Artist of the Month exhibit. Artists from across the territory are encouraged to apply to be a featured artist in our 2021 season which will run from January 4th to the end of June, 2021 for a total of 6 artists.

The feature artist's work will be displayed at NACC for every show open to the public, on-line and to view by appointment. Art will also be available for purchase through NACC either in person or by phone.

For the 2021 Season, NACC is continuing to collaborate with the NWT Arts Program to ensure artists have updated website profiles and marketing materials to accompany their display. NWT Arts will also cover the shipping/insurance of artwork to and from Yellowknife for artists who are chosen from communities outside the capital city. We are excited to announce that NWT Arts has provided a new display panel, lights and hanging system for this exhibit area, which will greatly improve the presentation of featured artwork.

Artists from all over the NWT have participated in past exhibits, including Jessica McVicker, Terry Pamplin, Tonya Makletzoff, Tracey Bryant and many others. These monthly exhibits are made possible thanks to NorthwesTel's generous support.
