We want to hear from professional, creative, and out-of-the-box photography teams to plan & coordinate photographing of all aspects of the Long John Jamboree and Inspired Ice Carving Championship, beginning with site preparation in late January, and lasting until the three-day festival at the end of March.

This contract will be awarded to the team who provides an original visual concept, and strategic plan to ensure that all aspects of the Jamboree are captured. The successful team will retain all credit on all imagery. All photographs will become property of the Long John Jamboree, for their exclusive use now and in perpetuity.

The photography team will be expected to shoot all components of the Inspired Ice Carving Championship, including (but not limited to):

- Site preparation, snow clearing, and ice block harvesting (proper safety measures are non-optional, and completely at the discretion of Inspired Ice staff);
- Creation of on-site infrastructure & site set-up;
- Advance events, such as the opening reception, Mardi John, and skill-sharing workshop;
- All events & features of the Long John Jamboree, including concession, artist market, sports events, and musical performances;
- All ice carvings, in process of completion, and high-quality photos of the completed carvings;
- The contribution of volunteers & Directors to the Jamboree;
- The final destruction of the ice carvings after the Jamboree.
